

Know all men by these presents that I *Wren Grayson* of the county
of *Blount* and the state of Tennessee, do constitute, make and appoint

Calvin Gideon Morgan of the *Knowville*

and state aforesaid, my true and lawful attorney, for me, and in my name
to ask, demand and receive from the person who may be appointed paymaster, such sum
or sums of money as is due me for my services, from the United States for a tour of du-
ty performed on a campaign under the command of

commencing on the *20th September* 1814 and ending on the *third of*
May 1815 as will appear by the annexed discharge. I also empower

my said attorney to sign all receipts necessary for the receiving of my money, and to act
and to do all things in and about the premises in as full a manner as I could do, were I
personally present.—In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at

this *26th* day of *September* 1815
