GIFT OF A FRIEND

This newest pavilion at the Michael Reese Hospital Medical Center is named as a perpetual memorial to the parents of the late Dr. Emanuel Friend. After studying medicine at the University of Heidelberg, Dr. Friend returned to Chicago and was one of the first physicians appointed to the staff of Mandel Clinic when it opened on the West Side in 1893. He was appointed to the Medical Staff of Michael Reese Hospital in 1895. In many years of active medical practice, Dr. Friend observed the need for a specialized patient facility to fill the gap between the hospital and the home. When he passed away in 1938, Dr. Friend left a fund which now amounts to approximately \$2,400,000 for construction and maintenance of such a specialized facility to be located at Michael Reese. As executors of Dr. Friend's estate, the Northern Trust Company has constructed this pavilion here.
