AJ Grayson volunteered upon Lincoln's call when Fort Sumter was attacked. He enlisted as a sergeant in the 6th Indiana regiment for the 3 months campaign in Virginia and was at the first battle of the Civil war in Philippi, VA. Upon discharge, he married and then re-enlisted as a lieutenant. He saw action at the greatest battle of the war in the West at Shiloh, then resigned and returned to Madison, IN. He became a printer and writer.

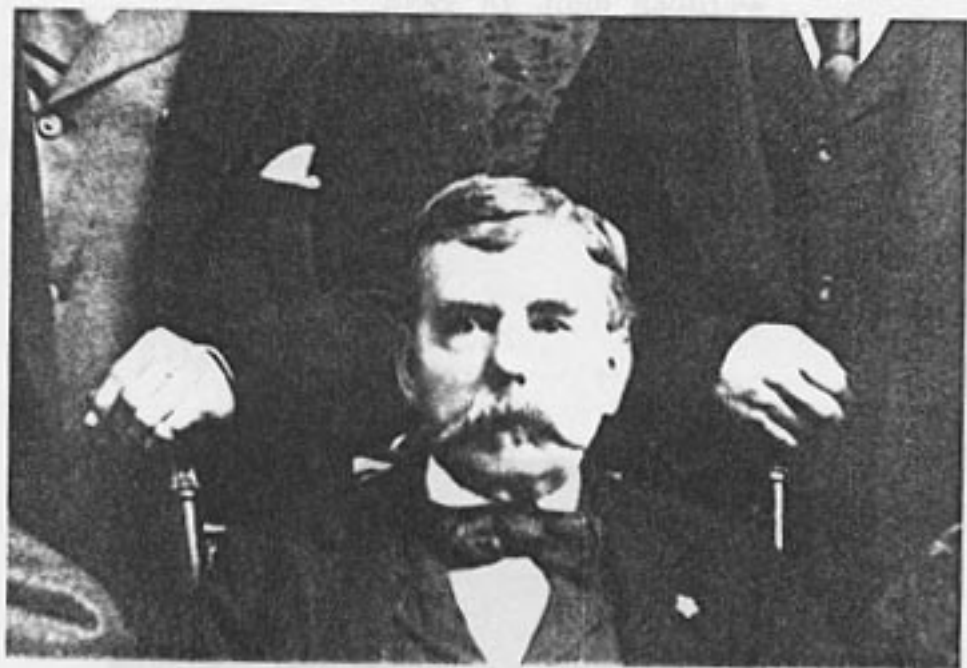
Matilda Grayson, his wife, died at age 56 on July 28, 1899. The Madison Courier devoted almost a full column to her obituary the following day. Besides her children she left 2 sisters and 1 brother: Mrs. John Pollock of Battle Creek, Mich., and Mrs. Thomas McNutt, nee Wirt in Jefferson County, Ind. The brother, Oliver Lawrence, lived in Dayton, Ohio. She "was of a lovely and lovable disposition, devoted to home and fireside." ... She was a member of Trinity M.E. Church. Her 4 sons and 2 sons-in-law served as pall bearers. "She was the center of a beautiful homelife which she created and held together. She lived to realize the brightest and best reward that can come to womanhood--the satisfaction of seeing her family grown to maturity, filling honorable stations in life, respected and useful."

Howard had a job with Todd and Gerkhe grocery store on Broadway near Belmont. He moved in with Grandma Wahlgren at first, then rented 1900 block on Western Avenue, 1905 - 06. Then Grandma Grayson built a house with money she inherited from Uncle Lafe (Lafayette Heidell) next to her mother's house at 4824 Bell Avenue.

Roland "refused to be poor", so he went to work after graduating from grade school. He went to work at Sheridan Trust and Savings Bank at Lawrence and

Broadway at age 15. His job was to carry a 32 and a 38 - two pistols with over \$50,000 to the Loop. His parents encouraged him to quit school so they could get room and board from him to help support the three sisters. Roland went to the Methodist Church because it was close. Dad was a printers devil one summer, age 13-14 at a Methodist Book Concern. Howard and Una Mae went to church only when they had to. Howard worked 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., seven days a week and had so little time at home. He did not want to go to church.

Recognition of Retirement of Richard Roland Grayson, MD.  
October 17, 2008 Introduction by Dr. Paul Gekas:

Richard Roland Grayson recently was made an honorary member of the medical staff at Delnor-Community Hospital after forty-five years of service. He joined the medical staffs of Delnor Hospital and Geneva Community Hospital in 1963, when he moved here from Elmhurst, Illinois, where he had been practicing since 1960. He was one of the first physicians in the area to practice the speciality of internal medicine. To that end, he served as the Chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine for three years and also was Committee Chairman of the Bioethics Department from 1990 to 1995. During this time, Dr. Grayson was a senior Federal Aviation Medical Examiner. He served the tri-city area by being Medical Examiner for the Department of Rehabilitation and Disabilities, taught a course on science and religion at Aurora University, was a member of the Saint Charles Board of Health from 1963 to 1990, and was a physician consultant for the Illinois Youth Center for a number of years. He also had a particular interest in the effects of stress on the body, especially its relation to peptic ulcer disease. In that regard, he founded the American Academy of Stress Disorders and served as its national president from 1971 to 1975. Richard Grayson was born in Chicago, Illinois, in 1925. In 1943, at age 17 He attended Wabash College in Crawfordsville, Indiana., he

became an apprentice seaman in the U.S. Navy during WW II. He rose to the rank of Lt. j.g. He transferred to the University of Illinois and in a span of 3 1/2 years, obtained both a bachelor of science degree as well as doctor of medicine degree, graduating at age 22. Because there was no formal training in internal medicine at that time, he then spent two years at Cook County Hospital in their rotating internship program. He transferred to the US Air Force after internship at Cook County Hospital with the rank of Captain and took training as an aviation medical examiner.

The next ten years of his life were very prolific. From 1950 to 1952, he served in the U.S. Air Force, rising to the rank of captain. From 1952 to 1957, he was in private practice in Perryville, Missouri. Recognizing in 1958, that he needed more training if he wished to exclusively concentrate on diseases of adults, he took a fellowship in endocrinology and cardiology at Washington University in St. Louis, Missouri. Dr. Grayson has published 36 articles in his lifetime, many of which were published between 1952 and 1960. He was the first person to describe diseases of the lung in silo fillers in the farms of Missouri. This article entitled, "Nitrogen Dioxide Pneumonia: A New Disease in Agricultural Workers", was published in the Annals of Internal Medicine. This was a significant landmark article in describing that condition for the first time ever. A few years later, he wrote an equally significant article which was published in the American Journal of Medicine, entitled "Factors Which Influence the Radioactive Iodine Thyroid Uptake Test". This article has been cited numerous times, both in other articles as well as textbooks and journals. Outside of medicine, Dr. Grayson has an FCC advanced amateur radio license and was a member of the Toastmasters, Lions, Rotary and Kiwanis. He is a member not only of the Mayflower Descendants, but also a member of the Society of the War of 1812 and of the Sons of the American Revolution. He is a member of the Sons of the Union Veterans of the Civil War, because his great-grandfather, Andrew Jackson Grayson, fought at the battle of Shiloh, under General Ulysses S. Grant.

Enough reasons have built up to finally result in the launch of my blog. It seems that everybody is asking me to let them know how things go at the competition I'm doing in Israel this October, and I've decided this is the best way. There's so much to tell! This competition is not just about what happens in October, but everything that goes into preparing it. The reason I chose to entitle this blog "Beyond the Moment" (other than the fact that there's a big title area up there demanding me to enter one) was to emphasize that for

every fleeting, seemingly effortless moment of performance, countless hours of all various kinds of preparation have been done to ensure that that moment comes across with just the right effect. This is my story of not just the moment of performance, but the real adventure beyond that moment.

In the interest of starting from the beginning, I'll introduce myself. Hello, I'm Elizabeth. :) I am a harpist – a decision undertaken as I was starting college and realized that I had been irreversibly enchanted by the harp and therefore had no choice but to major in it. According to my mother, my whole musical career began by tying shoes at the age of two, which gave her the idea that my fledging finger dexterity could be developed to do things even more interesting than tying my shoes. I don't remember this shoe-tying incident, just as I don't remember life without music lessons. I was lucky to have a really supportive family who raised me to appreciate the importance of music, even if they aren't professional musicians themselves. Over 20 years later I now have made it through the rigor of classical concert-artist training and have degrees from the University of Illinois' Music Department and the Ecole Normale de Musique de Paris. I live in Paris, by the way! “Yes, I'm American,” I say to all the French people who can't quiet figure out where my accent is from. “Yes, I love living in Paris, and the musical environment here is great,” I say to all the Americans who ask. Really, my enjoyment of Paris depends on my mood. Some days it all just makes me want to scream. Most of the time it's wildly stimulating and exciting.

Having just concluded my formal education, I am now entering the International Harp Competition in Israel, which will take place in October. Learning to be a concert artist is done by facing a series of challenges – class recitals, then recitals of your own, local competitions, then bigger competitions... – each time learning from your experience, and then being capable of more the next time around. The competition in Israel is going to be the last big challenge of this sort that I give myself. I really want to be done with competitions for good after this, so I made sure to choose one that was completely off-the-charts ridiculously hard, just so I would really feel like I'd gone all the way, made the best effort possible, and would be justified in moving on afterward.

By way of introduction, the International Harp Competition in Israel (hereafter abbreviated as just “Israel”) is one of the most prestigious harp competitions in the world. Because it is the oldest of the most prestigious harp competitions, it could be thought of as the most prestigious. This is, however, the last time you'll hear me talk about it like that. I don't like the way that calling Israel prestigious implies that I'm prestigious for doing it. Prestige is absolutely not the reason I chose to enter this competition.

For those who don't know, I'll give a bit of an explanation of how the competition works. On October 6th, about 30 talented, hard-working, and completely insane young harpists from all corners of the world will show up in Tel Aviv. We have known about the required repertoire for the competition and have been working on learning and perfecting those pieces for two years. The pieces range from solo works to small chamber ensemble to full, orchestral concerto, and they are all extremely,



technically challenging.
