Funeral For Henry Kinne Is Friday

Henry O.E. Kinne, 76, of Algona, died Tuesday morning at the Kossuth County Hospital where he had been a patient since Friday, April 30.

Funeral services will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday in the Trinity Lutheran Church with Rev. John Schenck officiating. Burial will be in the Dayton (Ia.) cemetery.

Pallbearers are Leo Gorman, Dennis Olson, Dennis Seefeld, Roland Lenz, Kenneth Meyer and Alfred Kohlhaas.

Henry O.E., son of Henry C. and Emilie Riechenbach Kinne, was born Sept. 16, 1899 in Burnside Township of Webster County, Ia. He attended parochial school and graduated from the eighth grade at Rufers School. Mr. Kinne also attended Tobin Business College at Ft. Dodge.

He was married to Lydia Augusta M. Hinz in St. Paul's Lutheran Church at Fairmont, Minn. by Pastor O.H. Zemke. The couple farmed in Minnesota, Burnside and Clare, Ia. until 1942 when they moved to a farm near LuVerne. Mrs. Kinne died unexpectedly Dec. 31, 1964 on the way home from church after attending communion service with her husband.

May 11, 1969 Mr. Kinne was married to Elfriede Gertrude Leischke of West Berlin, Germany. Pastor Paul H. Sohn performed the marriage in the Trinity Lutheran Church at Algona. Mr. Kinne farmed north of LuVerne, retiring in 1968. They continued to live in the farm home until moving into Algona in 1971.

He is survived by his wife, Elfriede, three sons, two daughters and one stepdaughter; Donald Kinne, Gilmore City; Lillian, Mrs. Arnold Niemeyer, Arvada, Colo.; Luther, LuVerne; Carol, Mrs. Melbourne Trampel, Clear Lake; Carl, Costa Mesa, Calif.; and Vera-Ellen, Mrs. E.J. Taylor, Orlando, Fla. There are 22 grandchildren and ten great-grandchildren.

He is also survived by one sister, Emelie Lind, Woolstock, Ia.

Mr. Kinne was preceded in death by his first wife, one son, James, parents, two brothers and three sisters.
