In the previous chapter the children and a few of the grandchildren of Andrew Jackson Grayson were mentioned. The relationships and names of his children and grandchildren are of importance because many are alive today and the great grandchildren and their children will be confused without some way to find a path through this thicket of people.

Therefore we have reprinted herein our rough charts of generations 2 and 3 with annotations and sources. The obituaries of George and William were available so these were included, as were 2 other clippings about William.

We have a book of charts of this nature which describe all the known Grayson relatives which is about 3 inches thick and perhaps other chapters of these charts will be appropriate later.


The title of the generation s was arbitrarily started with number one as being the generation of Richard Grayson, numbering backward in time. Andrew's generation becomes number 4; John Wren Grayson, his father, number 5; Wren Grayson, Sr., n umber 6; and his father Benjamin Grayson, n umber 7. Daniel Grayson's generation becomes number zero. Eventually we plan to re-number the generation s when we prove who the first Grayson to arrive in America was. The immigrant Grayson when found should be number 1.

We theorize that Benjamin Grayson of Wilkes county will be found to be either generation 2 or 3 in the new chronology.

SHORT ILLNESS IS DATAL FOR GEO. GRAYSON

George E. Grayson, a retirted letter carrier and formerly a city councilman, died yesterday afternoon at 3:45 at his home, 624 E. Second street, after an illness of two week's duration.

Mr. Grayson was 82 years of age and a native and life resident of Madison. He was a son of the late Andrew J. and Matilda Lawrence Grayson and the last member of his immediate family.

When a young man he accepted a position with the U. S. postal servace and served as a letter carrier 43 years, having retired 20 years ago last month.

Mr. Grayson was interested in civic affairs and served the public in several capacities during his later years. He was elected to the city counciland served as chaimman of the board of public works and safety under the late Mayor Marcus R. Sulzer.

During the disastrous 1937 floodMr. Prayson was head of city activities, and was in charge of a vast cleanup and rehabilitation program that followed.


As board of works and safety chairmann he also supervised construction of Crystal Beach the following year. A tablet in the problem stone pool bath house wall at the pool bears the name of Mr. Grayson, Mayor Sulzer, Paul Dowell, then city attorney: George H. Shaffer, superintendent of construction (WPA representative and Lester Routt, architect.

Mr. Grayson had served on the county board of tax adjustment and also for some years was deputy assessor in the city. At the time of last illness and death he was a member of

At the time of last illness and death he was a member of the county alcoholic beverage board, a position he held for a number of years. He was also a member of the United Evangelical Church, Modern's Woodmen of America, and was secretary-treasurer of the Jefferson Association, and organization of Members of the former Knights of Pythias lodge in Madison.

He is survived by his wife, Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Grayson; a daughter, Mrs. John E. McGuire, of this city, and a grand-daughter Miss Mary Elizabeth Demarce, also of Madison. Another daughter, the late Mrs. Gladys M. Demarce, preceded him in death last March.

Funeral services will be conducted Sunday afternoon at 2;30 in the Gans Funeral Home, and burial will be in Springdale cemetery. Friends may call at the residence until Sunday.
