

THE GRAYSON FAMILY TREE.

Joseph & Elizabeth Patsy (Brazil) Grayson lived in Anderson County, Tenn. Joseph Grayson was a English descent and a farmer and blacksmith by occupation.

Elizabeth Patsy Grayson was the daughter of William (Willis) Grayson of South Carolina. Who is listed as a soldier of the Revolution.

Joseph Grayson who located near Stephens Chapel, where they later moved to Marion County, entering seventy acres of land, upon which Byron Hudson family now resides, and there his death occurred, while his wife died on a farm near the Burnette School house.

*** HENRY GRAYSON ***

Henry Grayson, the son of Joseph & Elizabeth Patsy Brazil Grayson was born in Anderson County, Tenn. Nov. 2, 1799. He married Nancy Hixson Sept. 11, 1820 in Bledsoe County. Nancy Hixson was born in Greene County, Tenn. July 22, 1799 the daughter of William and Ingola Hugles Hixson. Their children names are Pleasant C. Grayson was born 1821; Louisa Grayson was born 1823; William Hixson Grayson was born April 12, 1826; Patrick H. Grayson was born Sept. 4, 1828; James M. During his younger years Henry Grayson engaged in blacksmithing and wagonmaking but later gave his entire time and attention to agricultural pursuits and milling business and also served as justice of the peace for a while.

Politically he was first a Whig and later a Democrat, and religiously inclined to the Christian Church, while his wife was a devoted member of the New Hope Cumberland Presbyterian Church. Henry Grayson departed from this life Nov. 9, 1879 was buried at the Burnette Cemetery.

Nancy Hixson Grayson died Nov. 10, 1881 at the home of her son Anderson Cheek Grayson in Whitwell, Tenn. Also was buried at the Burnette Cemetery.

Pleasant C. Grayson the first child of Henry and Nancy Hixson Grayson was born 1821 a farmer on the west side of Sequatchie river in the Third District. Pleasant was a member of Gov. Andrew Johnson's body guard at Nashville.

Liza Louisa the second child of Henry and Nancy Hixson Grayson was born 1823, who married Josiah Burnett and had a son Elijah Anderson Burnett who married Mrs. Mary Jane White Hudson and had a son William Anderson Burnett of (Harthford Michigan).

William Hixson Grayson the third child of Henry & Nancy Hixson Grayson was born April 12, 1826 on the old Ashburn farm just above Whitwell, Tenn. William H. Grayson was married Dec. 5, 1849 the lady of his choice being Miss Sarah Cowan who was born in Jackson County, Ala. April 1, 1827. Their children names are Joseph, Esther Louisa wife of Byren Hudson, Samuel H., Francis M. who was born April 13, 1852 and died in 1885; Henry C. and Nancy both died in infancy P.L. who died at the age of twenty seven years and Cynthia who married Thomas Smith and died in Arkansas.

William Grayson during his boyhood and youth pursual his duties in the Burnette school and those at Red Hill and Looney's Creek this acquiring a good paractical education which has well fitted him for life responsible duties. Early in life he learned the blacksmith's trade which he followed in connection with farming until the Tennessee coal Iron and R.R Company opened up their mines at Whitwell, when he took charge of their blacksmith shop but after conducting it one year he returned to the farm. He was a pronounced Republican in politics; acceptably served as justice of the peace in the Third district for fourteen years and several times acted as chairman. He and wife were member of the Cumberland Presbyterian Church.

Patrick H. Grayson the fourth child of Henry & Nancy Hixson Grayson was born Sept. 4, 1828. On the 26th of Sept. 1850 he led to the marriage altar Miss Martha J. Moore who was born in the Third district of Marion in June 1830 and is a daughter of George and Nancy E. (Davis) Moore.
