Among the English, American, and Caribbean ancestors of this Jean de Vassal, the title "Seigneur de Rignac" was altered to "Lord of Rinart," and because the common ancestor had emigrated from Caen, Normandy, this fictional place of Rinart was purported to be in that vicinity. The correct title is, of course, "Seigneur de Rignac," and the possessions are at Rignac, 46500, France, near the ancient de Vassal holdings south of the Dordogne River, especially at Fraysinnet-le-Gourdonnais, Vaillac, and Creysse.

---

The de Vassal Family is a family of great antiquity.

The place from which the family apparently derives its name, Vassel (Vassel, 63910, France), is located just east of Clermont Ferrand.

In 1276 a Bertrand de Vassal, Lord of Aver wrote a letter to another Bertrand de Vassal, Lord of Frayssinet (Les monographies d'Edmond Albe, Inventaire de pièces variées tirées de divers fonds, Famille de Vassal - 1276. Bertrand de Vassal, seigneur d'Aver. Apparenté à autre Bertrand de Vassal, seigneur de Frayssinet.

A member of the de Vassall family was a "hermano-sargento" in the Order of the Knights of the Templar in the late 13th century. Roger de Flor (c. 1265 - 1306) is recorded as having entered this de Vassal's service at the age of 15 (abt. 1280).

Other sources claim that in ancient times members of the de Vassal family were Barons of Gourdon in Perigord (Gourdon, 46300, France. Not far from Cahors) and Lords of/near Quercy (Quercy, Caylus, 82160 France).

The de Vassals were at Creysse (Creysse, 46600 France. Just north east of Gourdon) from the 14th century.

François de Vassal (c. 1545 - 1617) married Anne de Saintours (c 1545 - ?), the daughter of Jean de Saintours, Seigneur de La Bourélie.

Albine de Vassal (1779 - 1848) married Charles-Tristan de Montholon-Sémonville (1783 - 1853) and had Charles Frédéric de Montholon-Sémonville (1814 - 1886)

The same Albine de Vassal is reported to have been a mistress of Napoleon Bonaparte, Empereur de France (1769 - 1821)

Their daughter was Joséphine Napoléone de Montholon (1818 - 1819)

Je m'éloigne un peu de la commune de Creysse pour vous décrire ces ruines d'un caracrère tout particulier et sin gulièremennt imposantes situées au fond de la gorge sur la gauche en contre bas de la route de Creysse à Martel et qui sont presque en limite de notre territoire communal.

De nombreuses personnes, randonneurs et autres, m'ont souvent demandé l'origine de cet édifice situé sur la commune de Martel, et que tous les Creyssois aperçoivent en se rendant au canton ou en venant à Creysse.

XIVe siècle - Le premier texte connu date de 1343, donation par Raynal de Pons, du mas de la Soucque ou Fact de Tournemire à Guillaume de Vassal. L'ancien propriétaire du mas était Guy de Tournemire, bourgeois de Martel.

Le nouveau propriétaire, Guillaume de Vassal, appartient à une vaste famille, il est chevalier docteur ès lois, coseigneur de Fraissinet (près de Gourdon) seigneur de Loupiac et Belcastel.. C'est un homme de confiance de la maison Pons, il est gouverneur de la ville de Martel en 1352 et capitaine Pour le Roy. A noter qu'il est question de mas ou fact et qu'il n'est pas fait allusion à un château. Il s'agit d'un fief unique à l'hommage réservé.
